

ASK: Ask • Seek • Knock - The Church that Prays

Get ready to experience the power of prayer by seeking God through worship, encouraging messages, and great discussion.

Man to Man – Men’s MIX Group

Have you ever stopped to consider the people who has influenced your life in a positive way? Most of us can identify at least one or two people who have truly made a difference in our lives through their example, instruction or simply their friendship. God did not design us to go through this life alone. *Proverbs 27:17 says, “As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another” (NIV)*. No one better understood this dynamic than Jesus did when he made himself a servant and walked in an intentional relationship with a few men. *Mark 10:45 says, “For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.”* The result was a world radically changed.
